## **Greetings from your Health Ministry!!**

- **JULY! WOW!!** Here we are and half the year is spent.
- **Summer** is getting ready to heat up. Be sure and drink 64 ounces of water per day minimum **UNLESS** your doctor tells you otherwise.
- Our focus this month is **Stress & Health**. Anyone feeling stressed? I know I do, sometimes. How are you handling stress?
- **People "feel" Stress** in many ways and our feeling of Stress is demonstrated in many ways. Look at the bulletin board in the Commons Area and watch the overhead and bulletin. I am here to listen if you need an ear.
- **HEALTH**. Be pro-active in your Health. Wash your hands. Avoid crowds. Get outside. Wear a mask, as needed. Limit TV/Screen time. Choose 1 healthy food in place of a less healthy food. Laugh-it does your mind, soul and Spirit well.
- **Get enough sleep. CHOOSE HEALTH**. Read your Bible regularly. Talk to God, i.e.: prayer. He loves to hear your voice. Be friendly.
- July's focus is Water & Summer Safety! Swim with a buddy. Can't swim? Take Swim Lessons. Obey the lifeguards and signs. Wear a life jacket. NEVER DIVE into unknown water such as a shallow pool, area you have Never swam in before, etc. Apply Sunscreen BEFORE going outside or into the pool. Reapply Sunscreen often! Wear a Hat to protect your head & Sunglasses to protect your eyes. DRINK "5" 16-20-ounce bottles of Water every day (unless the doctor has instructed you otherwise.) If you are active or sweating, drink more water. Rest frequently OUT of the Sun. Alcoholic beverages along with caffeinated drinks increase Dehydration. Avoid these. Be aware of your surroundings. Look. Take a First Aid Kit with you. If a storm arises, get INSIDE quickly. If lightning is near, Get out of the WATER. LOOK. LOOK before crossing the street. Stop. LOOK again. Know where shelters are to get out of dangerous Weather. Refresh your CPR & First-Aid Skills. Summer is time for fun!! Planning ahead will help you have FUN!!! ENJOY!!
