  - 2. Not all stress is bad.
  - 3. Prolonged stress can harm your health.
  - 4. There are ways to manage stress.
  - 5. If you are overwhelmed, ask for help from your doctor, family, friend, pastor, church nurse, etc.

- Water & Summer Safety! Swim with a buddy. Can't swim? Take Swim Lessons. Obey the lifeguards and signs. Wear a life jacket.
