The Cleveland Clinic states "Stress is a normal reaction the body has when change(s) occur. Your body can respond to these changes physically, mentally or emotionally."
- 5 Things to Know about Stress from National Institute of Mental Health:
 - 1. Stress affects Everyone.
 - 2. Not all stress is bad.
 - 3. Prolonged stress can harm your health.
 - 4. There are ways to manage stress.
 - 5. If you are overwhelmed, ask for help from your doctor, family, friend, pastor, church nurse, etc.

Jesus told us in John 14:27 this; "Peace I leave to you; my peace I give to you, not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled nor afraid." ESV
- Water FUN & Safety ALWAYS SWIM with a Buddy. LOOK before Entering the water or Pool. Apply SUNSCREEN before entering the water & hourly, thereafter.
