Domestic Violence includes **Elder Abuse**, which is when someone harms or neglects a person age 60 or older. It can happen to anyone; no matter the person's age, sex, race, religion, or ethnic or cultural background. It can come from a caregiver, a family member, or a neighbor. It can take place in the older person's home, the home of a relative, or in an <u>assisted living</u> or nursing facility.

Older people living with abuse may be afraid or embarrassed to talk about it. But if you keep your <u>eyes</u> open and know what to look for, you can help make sure your friends and loved ones stay safe.
