- **"EXERCISE HAS RESUMED!** We are socially distanced and wearing masks. The class is limited to 10 people. We meet in the Family Life Center on Mondays & Thursday. Join us for health & happiness."

- **Week 2 of the 'Living a Healthy Life Class'** was very interactive and insightful about Health Goals & Sugar. Do you know that women & children are to have, at most, 6 teaspoons of sugar per day? Men? 12 teaspoons per day! How much sugar do you and your family consume in a day? week? Look at the food labels on your foods and see how much sugar it has. If the label doesn't list sugar, look at the Carbohydrate amount (which converts to sugar). One teaspoon of sugar equals 16 calories and 4 grams. One gram Carbohydrate equals four calories. - **Stress** is a part of life, BUT too much Stress is unhealthy. Another tool to reduce stress is to go for a 30-minute walk. Another tool is "Diversion". Re-direct your mind to good things, joyful times, God and His Word. In Philippians 4:8-9, We are told to think on certain things. These are the "things" Paul tells us to think on (Meditate on); truth, honorable, just, pure, lovely, commendable, excellence and anything worthy of praise.
- **COVID-19 Vaccine-** Vaccines continue to be administered by local area health departments & some hospitals. Rowan Health department continues Wednesday clinics 9:30am -3:30pm or until vaccine is gone. It is at West End Plaza, Salisbury. Enter off Statesville Blvd. All appointments are filled at Cabarrus Arena through January 29, 2021. Iredell County continues Wednesday Clinic at Mazepa Park, using numbers given out at arrival. **PLEASE NOTE - YOU MUST RECEIVE THE SAME VACCINE TYPE FOR BOTH INJECTIONS.
