Men? 12 teaspoons per day! How much sugar do you and your family consume in a day? week? Look at the food labels on your foods and see how much sugar it has. If the label doesn't list sugar, look at the Carbohydrate amount (which converts to sugar). One teaspoon of sugar equals 16 calories and 4 grams. One gram Carbohydrate equals four calories.
