- **February is Heart & Stroke Awareness Month.** In the coming weeks you will receive information about your physical heart, your spiritual heart, your mind, body-Your Whole Self.
- Today is "**RED DAY**"! Thank you for wearing something **RED** to raise **AWARENESS** about Heart Disease. Heart -Constantly beating, circulating, regulating, never sleeping, giving you life. WOW!! Since our hearts do So Much for us, let us love our heart by choosing to make healthier, life giving choices.

- **Prospect is purchasing a new AED** (automated external defibrillator) for our Family Life Center.
