

# **Greetings from your Health Ministry!!**

- **EXERCISE** We are still meeting! No break for the **SUMMER**. We meet every Monday and Thursday at 11:00 am in the FLC. Hope to see everyone.
- SAVE the Date!! July 29<sup>th</sup> is our next Red Cross Blood Drive, here, in the Family Life Center. Sign up online or contact the church office or the church nurse. Volunteers are needed to help with the Blood Drive. Thank you-in Advance!!
- I hope everyone enjoyed "Hat & Sunglasses Day". It was a great reminder of protection from the effects of the Sun.
- 'Heat Exhaustion & Heat Stroke'' are very serious, including "Life Threatening." So when you are working outside on HOT days, take precautions to prevent either of these. Take FREQUENT "COOL" Rest breaks, drink 8-10 bottles of water, Gatorade, Pedialyte, etc. If you feel any of the Symptoms, Go TO the ER or Urgent Care.
- **Symptoms for Exhaustion include**: Extreme Fatigue, dizziness, weak & rapid pulse, headache, Excessive Sweating.
- Symptoms for Heat Stroke include: body temp > 104\*; hot & red flushed skin: low blood pressure; rapid pulse; Seizures; Irritability or Disorientation.
- What to do? Call 911!!! Come OUT OF the Sun & into a cooled area. Remove excess clothing. offer cold water if able to swallow. Begin to cool immediately using ice packs or even a garden hose. CALL 911! Both of these are serious adverse effects from the Sun.
- On the First Sunday of each month, there is a special "WORKOUT" at Daly's Gym called Barbells & Bible. Give them a call for more details @ 704-682-5982.

# How much water?

- The recommended daily amount of fluids is:
  - 5 glasses for 5 to 8 year-olds
  - 7 glasses for 9 to 12 year-olds
  - 8 to 10 glasses for 13+
- Drinking water or an appropriate sports drink is best.
- Avoid caffeinated beverages and overly sugary drinks.
- Drink more water when exercising or on a hot day.
- Be aware and act quickly if symptoms of a heat-related illness occurs.
