

- **EXERCISE** We are still meeting! We meet every Monday and Thursday at 11:00 am in the FLC. Hope to see everyone.
- As we continue into August focusing on Safety, this week I want to share about Storm & Power Safety. During Storms, get inside the house. Do not stand in the middle of the yard. Lightening can strike a person, especially outside. Tune into your local area Emergency Weather Station. Prepare-AHEAD OF NEED, a kit that has flashlights, extra batteries, matches, Cash, some canned foods/snacks, bottled water, medication supply for 2 days, First Aid Kit and portable, charged- battery powered cell for your cell. Tornados-get down to the basement or in the center room of a house. Cover your head with pillows or mattresses. "DO NOT TRY TO OUTRUN A TORNADO IN A VEHICLE. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT OUTSIDE DURING A TORNADO, LIE DOWN FLAT IN A GULLY OR ROADSIDE DITCH." FLOODING Move to "Higher Ground" before water moves in. DO not CROSS a Flooded Road. "Downed Power Lines"- Keep away from downed lines & notify 911 of the location. Keep an Emergency Kit in your car.
- Talk about what to do in an Emergency with your family-before an emergency occurs. Designate a meeting spot. Do practice "DRILLS". PLAN & PREPARE BEFORE A STORM HAPPENS.
