Greetings from your Health Ministry!!

- Our health focusses this month is Diabetes and how it may affect us. Diabetes is when your Blood Sugar is "consistently above" 120. A special test called a "Hemoglobin A1c Test (HgbA1c)" measures your blood sugar over the past 2-3 months. Less than 5.7mg/dl is normal range; 5.7 6.5 mg/dl is considered Pre-Diabetes and 6.5mg/dl or higher is considered Diabetes.
- **How is your ''Thankful November''?** What have you been thankful/grateful for the past days?
- As we continue our Diabetes Awareness, this week we are going to look at some things we can do to help ourselves. What can I do? I am so glad you asked! One in three people have Pre-Diabetes in the US. Pre-Diabetes can lead to Diabetes.
- Diet. Four little letters that will help us prevent Pre-Diabetes. Sugar. Decrease your Soda intake & replace with water or other non-sugary drinks. Drink 8 ounces of water 30 minutes before meals. Keep a Food Diary for a week. Write down EVERYTHING you eat or drink each day. Read food labels. Make it your goal to eat LESS THAN 40 carbohydrates each day. You can find the Carbohydrates per serving on the food labels. Learn how much "a serving" really is then adjust your portions. Eat more Vegetables. Example. A deck of cards is the approximate portion/serving of meat. Body Weight. When we are overweight, it causes a strain on our Pancreas, Heart & Bones. Our Pancreas plays an important role in the regulation of our Blood Sugar (Glucose) in our blood stream. Increased weight requires overtime for the Pancreas. Our heart must do double duty to supply blood to our body. Excess weight causes strain & stress on our joints & bones, making movement difficult.
- Exercise. Our body movements or the lack of moving, directly effects our weight & blood sugar. 30 minutes daily of movement helps to maintain our weight & blood sugar. Walking. Come to the church and walk the parking lot 2 times. Go to the park. Walk in your neighborhood. Take the steps. Get an Exercise Buddy. Exercise also helps in reducing Stress, which plays a role in MANY health problems, including Pre-Diabetes. There are NUMEROUS Exercise Videos on YouTube. When you limit your Carbohydrates to 40 per day, eat measured portions & move, your will lose weight and help lower your Blood Sugar to prevent Diabetes. Do you want control? Take baby steps toward improved & better health. YOU can do this! Next week? Who is at risk for developing Diabetes?
