

- What is type 2 diabetes? Type 2 diabetes, the most common type of diabetes, is a disease that occurs when your blood glucose, also called blood sugar, is too high. Blood glucose is your main source of energy and comes mainly from the food you eat. Insulin, a hormone made by the pancreas, helps glucose get into your cells to be used for energy. In type 2 diabetes, your body doesn't make enough insulin or doesn't use insulin well. Too much glucose then stays in your blood, and not enough reaches your cells. The good news is that you can take steps to prevent or delay the development of type 2 diabetes.
- **Physical inactivity and certain health problems** such as high blood pressure affect your chances of developing type 2 diabetes. You are also more likely to develop type 2 diabetes if you have prediabetes or had gestational diabetes when you were pregnant. Learn more about risk factors for type 2 diabetes.
- Who is more likely to develop insulin resistance or prediabetes? People who have genetic or lifestyle risk factors are more likely to develop insulin resistance or prediabetes. Risk factors include:
 - \circ overweight or obesity
 - \circ age 45 or older
 - \circ a parent, brother, or sister with diabetes
 - African American, Alaska Native, American Indian, Asian American, Hispanic/Latino, Native Hawaiian, or Pacific Islander American ethnicity
 - o physical inactivity
 - health conditions such as high blood pressure and abnormal cholesterol levels
 - \circ a history of gestational diabetes
 - a history of heart disease or stroke
 - polycystic ovary syndrome, also called PCOS
- What is prediabetes? Prediabetes means your blood glucose levels are higher than normal but not high enough to be diagnosed as diabetes. Prediabetes usually occurs in people who already have some insulin resistance or whose beta cells in the pancreas aren't making enough insulin to keep blood glucose in the normal range. Without enough insulin, extra glucose stays in your bloodstream rather than entering your cells. Over time, you could develop type 2 diabetes.
