Heart Health and Spiritual Practice

Love the Lord your God with all your Heart, Soul and Mind. (Multiple Biblical Locations)

Studies suggesting religious involvement may affect health outcomes have been reported. A study appearing on the NIH website was designed to investigate whether scores on a questionnaire measuring spiritual wellbeing correlated with progression or regression of coronary heart disease as measure by cardiac catheterization data. Participants were selected from Dr. Dean **Ornish's Llifestyle Heart Trial** were given a Spiritual Orientation Inventory. A significant difference was found in the Spirituality scores between a control group and a research group that practiced daily meditation. The spirituality scores were significantly correlated with coronary artery obstruction over a 4 year time period. The lowest scores of spiritual well-being had the greatest progression of coronary obstruction and the highest Spiritual scores had the most regression of obstruction. The study suggests the degree of spiritual well-being may be an important factor in the progression of coronary artery disease.

An article on Harvard

Medical School website is titled <u>Spirituality can affect</u> <u>proteins linked to cardiovas-</u> <u>cular disease</u>. In addition to daily meditation, characteristics of a spiritually healthy heart are thought to include gratitude, hope, forgiveness, and love.

There is a large body of literature supporting effective spiritual interventions for the heart failure population. A 2018 search resulted in 30 peer reviewed articles involving spirituality and the heart failure population. Findings include descriptive evidence of the uniqueness of spirituality in this population as well as proposed interventions.
