- This week we will look at Depression. Most all of us experience feelings of sadness, loneliness, helplessness at 1 time or another. Having these feelings does NOT make us any less of a person or a Christian. Ongoing Stress & Anxiety can lead to Depression as well as chemical imbalances, grief and loss. Depression can present in various ways, from person to person. Following are some ways to deal with Depression.
- 1. Pray. Reflect. Read God's Word. If you are having a bad day, feeling down, encountering a situation you have NO control over, tell it to Jesus. He is interested in you; your thoughts, feelings, etc. You are NOT alone. God will NEVER leave you or turn His back on you. Psalm 23.
- 2. Practice Self-Care. No, self-care is NOT being selfish; it is rendering care & concern for yourself!! God's greatest Creation-You! Jesus practiced self-care. He made time and took time to enjoy healthy, positive people, places and things. Ecclesiastes 4:9
- **3. Take each day as it comes.** Do your BEST, today. Appreciate yourself. Love yourself. Don't worry about tomorrow or the next day(s). Matthew 6:3
- **4. Set Doable Goals.** Depression sets us up for failure using shame & condemnation. Romans 8:1. Make your goals easy, simple, measurable and obtainable. Write down a list of 3 things to complete by the end of the day. Mark them off as you do them. Go for a short walk or run.
- **5. Celebrate Little Wins.** Celebrate as you complete a goal-just for today. Write down your successes with each goal met. "Rejoice! And again, I say, Rejoice!"
- **6. Try Being Creative.** Pick up a former hobby or begin a new one. Stacking wood, hunting, sewing, cooking, sending cards, re-kindle friendships, paint, draw, color, laugh, find the cloud animals, look up, etc. You are created in God's creative image. Allow God to shine through you.
- 7. Talk to a counselor, pastor, therapist, nurse. Seeking out & receiving current resources will help you to overcome Depression.
- 8. Consider Medicine. Make a doctor's appointment for a physical. Tell your doctor what you think or feel. Medicine can be very helpful. Retrain your self-talk. Say about yourself what God says & thinks about you. Believe you are unconditionally: loved; fully accepted; and an Heir with God through Christ Jesus.
