Greetings from your Health Ministry!!

- **Exercise** - Mondays & Thursdays at 11am in the FLC. Join us!! We have room for you & are practicing social distancing, mask wearing & Hand Hygiene.
- **As we continue this month learning about the Sun**, our skin and skin cancer prevention, I want to share some steps we can take to care for our skin. Do you know that "The Skin" is the largest organ system in the body? It is! Prevention is the 1st step in caring for our skin. Use Sunscreen rated at least an SPF15. Apply BEFORE going outside & every 2 hours thereafter. Wear a wide brimmed hat, sunglasses, long sleeves & drink plenty of water. Avoid being out in the sun between 10 am - 2 pm, if possible. Work/play in the shade, when possible. Avoid Sunburns. Frequent Sunburns can increase the occurrences of Skin Cancers. Use Sunscreen developed for children, on children. Do you know Dogs can get Sunburned? Doggy Sunscreen is available. Human Sunscreen is harmful to Dogs.
- **Visually inspect your skin**- front & back; monthly. Know what your normal is & is not. An Annual Skin Screening by a dermatologist is recommended for prevention & early intervention.
