• July 17 - Please join us for water day at the pavilion on Sunday, July 17 after church (11:45 am). we will be grilling hot dogs and hamburgers for lunch. there will be pools, bubbles, water balloons, games, and a slip and slide. We will have kiddie pools for our younger friends so hopefully you will join us for

- July 17 & 24 NO Sunday School for grades 6th 12th!
- August 7 Pool party at The Cornett's House at 12;30 (after church). Bring your swimsuits and towels and be ready for fun. Also bring your favorite finger food to share for lunch and something to drink.

**CONGREGATIONAL TRIP:** We are planning a two-day trip to the mountains for outdoor fun. Exact details will vary, but below is a tentative plan. Day One: Friday, August 5: We will depart from the church around 9am and head to Erwin, Tennessee to USA Raft (approx. 3-hour drive). You can either choose to raft (ages 10+) or tube. The rafting trip is about 4 hours and \$90/person. The tubing trip is 1 hour at \$15/person, but you can make additional runs at \$10 per person. Afterwards, we will stay the night probably in Kingsport, TN, and more than likely at a church or somewhere low cost. Day Two: Saturday, August 6: We will bike the Virginia Creeper Trail. We plan to take the 9:30am shuttle to Whitetop and bike the 17 miles to Damascus, which is primarily downhill and usually takes 2-3 hours. If you have your own bike, cost for the shuttle is \$22/adult or \$18/child 12 & under. If you want to rent a bike, then cost for rental and shuttle is \$36/person. We will eat lunch when we finish the ride and head back to Mooresville (approx. 3-hour drive). We will work out transportation details to get bikes up there depending on who and how many are going. Also, we may be able to work it out so we can shuttle ourselves, in

which case, there will be no cost for the bike trip unless you want to rent a bike (\$15 for 4-hour rental). If there is anyone who would like to do one day but not both, that can be arranged as well. We need to know who all is interested no later than Sunday, July 10 so we can make reservations and work out final details.
