- **Prediabetes can be reversed**. You can go to <a href="www.amerciandiabetes.org">www.amerciandiabetes.org</a> for more information. Take the Screening & see what your numbers are.
- healthy diet. There are many eating plans that can help with type 2 Diabetes; everything from a Mediterranean Diet to low-carbohydrate to vegetarian diet. Controlling portion size is important. If you are out & about and find yourself without a measuring cup, you can estimate by using familiar objects such as a deck of cards or the palm of your hand is equal to a serving of meat; a woman's closed fist is approximately 1 cup; ½ of a Baseball is about a half a cup and a shot glass measures 2 tablespoons-jut the recommended salad dressing portion size. Food swaps is another way to manage type 2 diabetes. Try low-carb bread and food wraps. Use lettuce in place of bread. Substitute Olive or Canola Oil in place of Crisco or Butter. Use grilling, broiling, baking or stirfrying in place of frying or battering. Applesauce can be substituted in cake recipes in place of oil, with little to no change in taste. Cut back on added sugar. If a recipe calls for 1 cup, use 2/3 cup, etc. Try & use more spices while cooking, lemon or lime juice, garlic, etc.
