

Elevator News


Since the Congregational Meeting on August 17, 2023, the Elevator Team has been diligently working with True Craft Builders to finalize the design, details, and cost of the new elevator tower. The Elevator Team is now proud to announce that we have approved engineering drawings, a firm cost, and approved building permits from Rowan County to allow construction to begin. Unfortunately, during this time, costs have increased along with Rowan County inspectors requiring steel framing vs wood that also increased the cost to construct the elevator.

We have funds to begin construction. However, we still need donations and/or commitments to cover the gap between current funds and final cost of construction as well as any unforeseen problems during construction. Any remaining funds following construction can be used for elevator maintenance.

Perimeter fencing will be installed soon which will allow construction to start. During construction access will be blocked to the rear exterior door. Side exterior doors and the main staircase will still be available for use. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may create.


