"If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." – 2 Corinthians 5:17.

A New Year is a gift. A New Year is also a responsibility. For the most part, we all like new things. My father appreciated new things. My father spent his entire child- hood in the Depression and then in the Second World War. He was not poor, but he did not get a lot of new things growing up. My father enjoyed making sure my brother and I got a few more new things than he did. But my father always made sure we did not take the new things we received for granted. He often talked about how we had a responsibility to take care of the new toy or the new shoes or the new piece baseball glove. Account balances as of December 18, 2024 were reported as follows:

General Fund Balance - \$187,885 Development Fund Balance - \$81,869 Elevator Money Market - \$28,999 General Fund Reserve Balance - \$38,869
